Pastor's Letter

Church,

It is incredible to think that we are in the second month of 2026 already. God is doing amazing things in and through you and our church, and I am so thankful for all of you. My prayer and my hope for you in this month where we see hearts, candy, flowers, love, and romance is that you and I would seek to love well. Love is a small world, but its meaning is deep and complex. The Greeks used three different words for love. In comparison, in English we have one word: love. Philio is the Greek word which means friendship or brotherly love. This word for the naming of the Pennsylvania city Philadelphia and it is a casual friendship kind of love. Develop philio love in your life. Spend time with friends, enjoy hobbies, and live pursuing great joy in the philio aspect of love.

The Greeks use the word eros to mean romantic love. While romantic love is not the calling that God has on everyone's life it is a blessing for those who the Lord has given it to. In terms of eros love, exercise it under the authority of God's law. Obey God's commands. Stay faithful to your husband or your wife. Show affection. Listen deeply, but allow your eros love to point your spouse, fiancée, or significant other back to God.

The Greeks use the word agape to mean the love that never ends. When we discuss the love of God the word agape is always used. It is a love that sees people with grace and forgiveness. It is a love that is patient and kind. It is a love that causes us to be meek and love ourselves less. It is this love that causes us and reminds us we are to love well. I want to close with this verse for you in this month 1 John 4:7, "7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God."
